## **Training Division**

Our 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Summer Training in Paradise weekend was a great success for our members. We had twenty-one (21) of our members partake in a variety of courses over the four days. In total we had over 80 students from over 20 Fire Departments attended. We held eight courses (Critical Incident Stress Management, Command and Control, First Responder Instructor, Emergency Services Drone Pilot, Situational Awareness, Fire Service Instructor, Confined Space Operations and Incident Safety Officer. This year's new format allowed for some new training providers to lead the training. We had Vancouver Island Emergency Response Academy (VIERA), Dynamic Rescue Systems (DRS), Canadian Red Cross, Justice Institute of BC (JIBC) as well as a course led by Pender and Salt Spring Island fire department trainers.

## **Inspection and Public Education Division**

July we conducted forty-two (42) Commercial Fire Inspections and one re-inspection. Inspectors were also requested by CRD to conduct seven (7) Driveway inspections, and three (3) zoning inspections. One new Pre Incident plan was created for emergency response. A Fire Safety Plan review was also completed.

Our SSIFR Educators took part in the summer Library camp at the Salt Spring Island Public Library. Our attendance helped promote reading and fire and life safety education. Thirty-Five (35) Children attended the camp.
