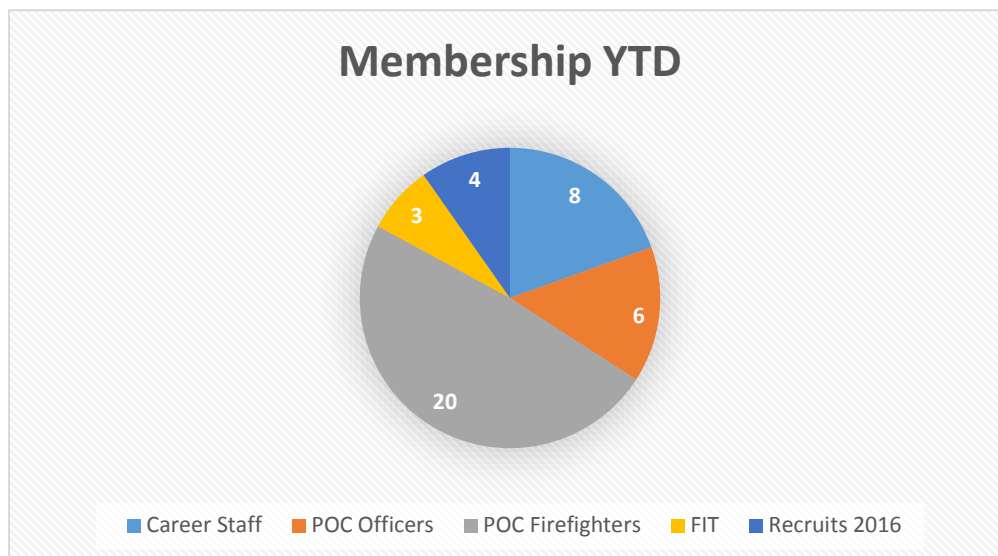
Operations Update

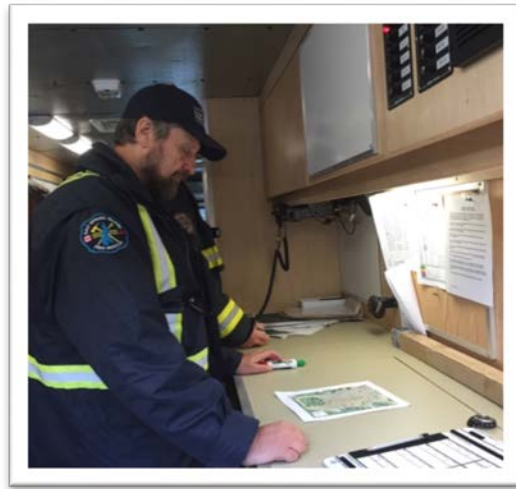
