**A Bylaw for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the
Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District for fire protection purposes.**

The Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of three million eight hundred thirty thousand one hundred fifty, (\$3,830,150) dollars is required by the Improvement District for fire protection purposes in the year 2021.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 2021 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with section 711 of the Local Government Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Protection Taxation Bylaw 2021".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on 19th day of October 2020.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 19th day of October 2020.

Bylaw No. 143**

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Wages and Benefits Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Wages and Benefits Reserve Fund of Two Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Sixty dollars and Thirty-Six cents (\$269,560.36) as of July 31, 2021.


AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend monies imposed under Bylaw No. 141 – Wages and Benefits Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw for the purpose of funding the costs of retroactive payment of wages for Call-out worked by career staff while on Stand-by Duty Shift.

The Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of One Hundred Seven Thousand One Hundred and One dollars (\$107,101.00) is hereby appropriated from the Wages and Benefits Reserve fund to be expended on payments to career members for 2017- 2019 Call-out while on Stand-by Duty Shift.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated will be specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance will be returned to the credit of the said Wages and Benefits Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Bylaw 143 - 2021 Reserve Funds Disbursement Bylaw".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Board of Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Improvement District on the 16th day of August 2021.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 16th day of August 2021.


