

# Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District

## Bylaw No. 149

A Bylaw for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the  
Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District for fire protection purposes.

The Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of four million, five hundred eighty-nine thousand, seven hundred and twenty-five (\$4,589,725.00) dollars is required by the Improvement District for fire protection purposes in the year 2023.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 2023 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with section 711 of the Local Government Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Protection Taxation Bylaw 2023".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 17th day of October 2022.
