BYLAW NO. 154

A Bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Fire Hall No. 1 Renewal Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Fire Hall No. 1 Renewal Reserve Fund of \$1,504,902.56 dollars as of April 30, 2023.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend monies imposed under Bylaw No. 133 – the Fire Hall No. 1 Renewal Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw for the purpose of upgrading, replacement or renewal of existing Fire Hall No. 1.

THE TRUSTEES of the **Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District** ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:


1. The maximum sum of \$1,504,902.56 is hereby appropriated from the Fire Hall No. 1 Renewal Reserve Fund to be expended on capital expenditures for the New Fire Hall Project located at 455 Lower Ganges Road, Salt Spring Island, BC.
2. The expenditures to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated will be specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance will be returned to the credit of the said Fire Hall No. 1 Renewal Reserve Fund to a maximum of the amount appropriated under Section 1.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Hall No. 1 Replacement Reserve Fund Disbursement Bylaw No. 154, 2023".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 19th day of June 2023.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 19th day of June 2023.


