

SALTSPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

BY-LAW NO. 18

A by-law for levying taxes on the land and improvements in the District for fire protection purposes.

The Trustees of Saltspring Island Fire Protection District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of \$45,000.00 is required by the District for fire protection purposes for the year 1972.
2. The basis of assessment for levying taxes to raise the said sum shall be the value of the land and improvements hereinafter mentioned.
3. A tax at such rate as may be determined by the Provincial Assessor for the Gulf Islands Assessment and Collection District to be necessary to raise the aforementioned sum is hereby levied for the year 1972 on all land and improvements as defined in the Public Schools Act within the District in accordance with Section 62 of the Water Act.
4. The said taxes shall be due on the 2nd day of July, 1972, and are subject to the provisions of Section 21 of the Taxation Act.
5. This by-law may be cited as the "First Taxation By-law, 1972".
