

BY-LAW NO. 22

A by-law for levying taxes on land and improvements within the SaltSpring Island Fire Protection District, hereinafter referred to as the "improvement district", for Fire Protection and Street Lighting purposes.

The Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$ 80,000.00) is required by the improvement district for 76,500.00 for Fire Protection and \$3,500.00 for Street Lighting for the year 1974.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary by the Provincial Assessor for the Gulf Islands Assessment and Collection District to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 1974 on all land and improvements as defined in the Public Schools Act, within the improvement district in accordance with section 62 of the Water Act and section 798G of the Municipal Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation Act until paid or recovered.
4. This by-law may be cited as the "Taxation By-law, 1974".
