A by-law for levying taxes on land and improvements within the SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION District, hereinafter referred to as the

"Improvement District", for FIRE PROTECTION \$81,000.00  
LOAN INTEREST \$10,000.00 - PAYMENT ON BANK LOAN \$25,000.00  
STREET LIGHTING \$3,500.00 purposes.

The Trustees of the SALT SPRING ISL. FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of ONE HUNDRED & NINETEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED Dollars (\$119,500.00) is required by the Improvement District for FIRE PROTECTION, STREET LIGHTING, LOAN REPAYMENT & LOAN INTEREST for the year 1975.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 1975 on all land and improvements as defined in the Public Schools Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with section 62 of the Water Act and section 798G of the Municipal Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation Act until paid or recovered.
4. This by-law may be cited as the "Taxation By-law, 1975".

Pursuant to the provisions of section 798H of the Municipal Act the administration of your Improvement District is now the responsibility of this Department.
