A by-law for levying taxes on land and improvements within the SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION District hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District" for Fire Protection \$91,058, Loan Repayment ~~purposes~~.

\$13,942, Expansion of Fire Hall \$5,000, Street Numbering \$5,000, Street Lighting \$6,000, Purposes.

The Trustees of the SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND Dollars (\$121,000.00) is required by the Improvement District for Fire Protection, Loan Repayment, Fire Hall Expansion, Street Numbering, and Street Lighting for the year 1977.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the afore-said sum is hereby levied for the year 1977 on all land and improvements as defined in the Public Schools Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with section 62 of the Water Act and section 798G of the Municipal Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation Act until paid or recovered.
4. This by-law may be cited as the "Taxation By-law 1977".



A by-law for levying taxes on land and improvements within the SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION District hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District" for FIRE PROTECTION, 91.058, LEAN LEGY & 13942 purposes. EXPANDED FIRE HALL 25000.00 STREET NUMBERS "5000" STREET LIGHTS 6000.0

The Trustees of the SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY ONE THOUSAND Dollars (\$121,000.00) is required by the Improvement District for FIRE PROTECTION, LEAN LEGY & FIRE HALL EXPANDED STREET NUMBERS & STREET LIGHTS for the year 1977.
