

BY-LAW # 40

A by-law for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District" for fire protection and street lighting purposes.

THE TRUSTEES of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of One Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 157,500.00) is required by the Improvement District for fire protection and street lighting for the year 1984.

2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 1984 on all land and improvements as defined in the Public Schools Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with Section 833 of the Municipal Act.

3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation Act until paid or recovered.

4. This by-law may be cited as the "Taxation By-Law 1984".


