

SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BY-LAW NO. 48

A by-law for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District" for fire protection and street lighting purposes.

THE TRUSTEES of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The sum of One Hundred and sixty-five thousand five hundred Dollars (\$165,500.00) is required by the Improvement District for fire protection and street lighting for the year 1988.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 1988 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with Section 833 of the Municipal Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This by-law may be cited as the "Taxation By-law 1988".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 23rd day of November, 19 87 .

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 23rd day of November, 19 87 .
