

**SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

**BYLAW NO. 61**

A bylaw for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District" for fire protection and street lighting purposes

**THE TRUSTEES of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of Two Hundred and Ninety-three thousand, four hundred and Seventy-Three (\$293,473.00) is required by the Improvement District for fire protection and street lighting purposes for the year 1993.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 1993 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with Section 833(6) of the Municipal Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Protection and/or Street Lighting Taxation Bylaw 1993".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 28th day of September, 1992.
