BY-LAW NO. 79

A By-law for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District" for fire protection and street lighting purposes.


THE TRUSTEES of the **Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District** in open meeting assemble ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of FIVE HUNDRED AND FOUR THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$504,350.00) dollars is required by the Improvement District for fire protection and street lighting purposes for the year 2000.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 2000 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with section 756 of the Municipal Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Protection and/or Street Lighting Taxation Bylaw 2000".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 15th day of October 1999.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 15th day of October 1999.
