

SALT SPRING ISLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Bylaw No. 81

A bylaw for levying taxes on land and improvements within the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District, hereinafter referred to as the "improvement district", for fire protection purposes in each of the years 2001 to 2015 both inclusive.


The Trustees of the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of \$282,600 is required by the improvement district for purchasing a fire truck.
2. Interest at a rate of 7% per annum shall be charged on the said sum from November 24, 2000 to July 1, 2001, making a total amount of \$294,490.84 as principal to be collected.
3. The said sum of \$294,490.84 with interest at 7% per annum shall be amortized in equal amounts over a period of fifteen years and during the years 2001 to 2015, both inclusive, an annual amount of \$30,218.23 shall be levied to meet the repayments of principal and the payment of interest together with a charge on the said amount for the cost of assessment and collection.
4. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid total annual sum is hereby levied for each of the years 2001 to 2015 both inclusive, on all lands and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the improvement district, for the years in which the annual amount is levied in accordance with section 756 of the Local Government Act.
5. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act, until paid or recovered.
6. This by-law may be cited as the "2000 Fire Truck Capital Tax Advance Bylaw."




