

# Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District BY-LAW NO. 96

A Bylaw for levying taxes on the land and improvements  
within the Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District  
for fire protection and street lighting purposes.

THE TRUSTEES of the **Salt Spring Island Fire Protection District** in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The sum of EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY, (\$849,150.00) dollars is required by the Improvement District for fire protection and street lighting purposes for the year 2005.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 2005 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with section 756 of the Local Government Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Protection and/or Street Lighting Taxation Bylaw 2005".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 2004.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 2004.
