AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 825 of the Municipal  
Act that the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may at any time amend the  
Letters Patent of any improvement district in any respect:

AND WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of Saltspring Island Fire Protection District have requested that the boundaries of the district be extended to include all and singular those parcels or tracts of land situate, lying and being as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the southeast Quarter of Section 42, South Saltspring Island, Cowichan District; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of the said Southeast Quarter of Section 42 of the southeast corner thereof; thence easterly, southerly and westerly along the northerly, easterly and southerly boundaries of the North Half of the Northwest Quarter of Fraction Section 40 to the southwest corner thereof; thence southerly and easterly along the westerly and southerly boundaries of the Northwest Quarter of Fractional Section 40 to the point of intersection with the middle line of an unnamed creek as shown on DD 23671<sup>I</sup>, on file in the Land Title Office Victoria; thence southeasterly along said middle line to the point of intersection with the northwesterly limit of Isabella Point Road as constructed on the ground; thence southwesterly along said northwesterly limit to the point of intersection with the westerly boundary of Fractional Section 40; thence southerly along said westerly boundary and continuing southerly along the southerly prolongation thereof to the point of intersection with a line drawn parallel to and 304.8 meters perpendicularly distant southerly from the natural highwater mark of Saltspring Island on the southerly shore thereof; thence in a general westerly direction parallel to and 304.8 meters distant southerly from the natural highwater mark of Saltspring Island on the southerly shore thereof to the point of intersection with the southerly prolongation of the westerly boundary of the Fractional East Half of Section 39; thence northerly along said prolongation and continuing northerly along the easterly boundaries of the Fractional West Half of Section 39 and the West Half of Section 42 to the aforesaid northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 42, being the point of commencement.

NOW KNOW YE THAT by these presents We do order and proclaim that the boundaries of the Saltspring Island Fire Protection District be amended as hereinbefore described, and that on, from, and after the date of these supplementary Letters Patent the boundaries of the Saltspring Island Fire Protection District be defined as follows:-


Commencing at the most easterly corner of Lot 29, Sections 64 and 68, South Saltspring Island, Cowichan District, Registered Plan 1914 on file in the Land Title Office, Victoria, being a point on the natural high-water mark of Burgoyne Bay, on the southerly shore thereof, thence southwesterly along the northwesterly boundary of Section 1, Range 1, to the most westerly corner thereof, thence southeasterly along the southwesterly boundaries of Sections 1 to 13, inclusive, Range 1, to the most northerly corner of Fractional Section 52; thence southerly and easterly along the westerly and southerly boundaries of said Fractional Section 52 to the northwest corner of the East Half of Section 42; thence southerly along the westerly boundaries of the said East Half Section 42 and the Fractional East Half of Section 39 to the southwest corner of the said Fractional East Half of Section 39; thence southerly along the southerly prolongation of the westerly boundary of the Fractional East Half of Section 39 to the point of intersection with a line drawn parallel to and 304.8 meters perpendicularly distant southerly from the natural highwater mark of Saltspring Island on the southerly shore thereof; thence in a general northerly, westerly and southerly direction parallel to and 304.8 meters perpendicularly distant from the natural highwater mark of Saltspring Island on the easterly, northerly and westerly shores thereof to a point which lies due north of the aforesaid most easterly corner of said corner being the point of commencement, save and except from the above described area Indian Reserve Number 5, "Fulford Harbour".

AND THAT the Letters Patent of the Saltspring Island Fire Protection District be deemed to be amended so as to conform to the premises as and from the date of these Letters Patent.
